1. The new academic session, 2025 - 26 for classes **Playgroup to XII** will commence from **Tuesday, April 1, 2025.**
2. **SCHOOL TIMINGS:** The school timings w.e.f. **Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025**, is as follows -

3. **UNIFORM:**

As of Tuesday, April 1, 2025, all students must wear the summer uniform, which is available at the uniform store for your convenience. Please ensure students are wearing complete and proper school uniform every day. Any other shoes or pants are strictly prohibited in the school premises.

4. **LUNCH:** Please make sure your child packs a nutritious lunch for school every day. Our school adheres to a strict **vegetarian diet**; thus, we gladly ask for your cooperation in this matter.

5. **PCH AND SCHOLAR BADGE:** We are continuing with the **Scholar Badge** in classes **VI to XII**, and **Proficiency Certificate Holder** badge for classes Playgroup to V.

6. **SCHOOL PLANNER:** General Guidelines are all included in the planner. Please ensure you read through the planner meticulously once in a week.

7. **OFF on SATURDAY:** - School remains off on all Saturdays except, if there is an update for working day.

8. **FEE GUIDELINES:** - The Parents are requested to deposit the fee as available in the fee challan for the session 2025- 26.

**\*Facility to deposit fee through school app is also available.**

**\*Late fee will be levied in case of delay in the payment i.e. ₹30 every day from 16<sup>th</sup> day of every quarter.**

**Please take note of the following points for the upcoming session:**

- 1) To be promoted to a higher class, you must have **75% attendance**. If a student misses class for seven days at a stretch, **a proper application should be provided** to the class teacher and Principal. If there is any health concern, **a physician's note** must also be sent.
- 2) **No damage should be done to school property**; students should not deface, scratch, or otherwise harm any school furniture, other people's property, or the walls with writing or drawing.
- 3) Any kind of gold and silver jewelry, rings, chains, bangles, anklets, Kada, bracelets etc., are not permitted in school for students. **If any expensive item is lost or stolen, the school administration is not liable.**
- 4) All types of electronic devices, including cameras, iPods, mobile phones, sharp objects like knives and blades and magazines, **are prohibited** in school premises. **If seized, it will only be returned at the end of the session or on payment of Rs. 2500/- as a fine.**
- 5) **Misbehavior and indiscipline in school transport** will not be appreciated and strict action will be taken.
- 6) Students should speak softly and politely and **communicate in English only.**
- 7) **PTI's are mandatory to be attended both by the parents and ward.** In case of any emergency, inform the class-teacher well-in-advance and take the appointment of any following day.

We seek your cooperation in collaborating with the school to help our children develop self-discipline, politeness and commitment towards their passion. This will enable us to hone their skills and make them liberal and exemplary citizens of the nation.
