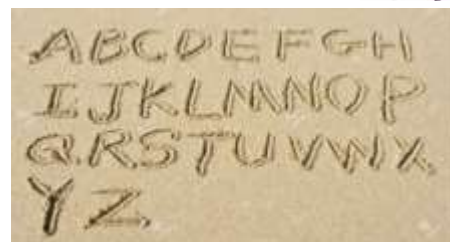
Letters B, C, D, G, J, O along with the vocabulary & Phonic sounds.
