SUBJECT-ENGLISH

1. Explore your vocabulary

Understand the difference between: Homonyms, Homophones and Homographs. Take an A3 size coloured sheet and explain the difference between them creatively (without using long explanations/ definitions). You can use pictures/ illustrations for explaining. Give at least 10 examples for each. You can decorate the sheet for better presentation.

2. Every family has a story to tell!

We all have millions of memories with our family members. Choose one of the best times you have spent with your family in the last two years. Take an A4 size coloured sheet, find and paste a picture for the memory, if you have and narrate it in as much detail as possible about when it happened, who were the people present, what you did, how it became so memorable, and why it is the best memory you can have. The experiences should be narrated in your own words. You can use some dialogues to add more emphasis. You are also free to add more than one picture to make it visually appealing.

BOOK BASED ACTIVITY (Choose any one)

1. BOOK REVIEW

Read the book you have been allotted carefully and make your short notes on the following points:

1. Book Title and Author
2. The characters from the story
3. The main story line/ Themes in the story
4. Which character did you like the most and why?
5. The summary of the story
6. Any paintings/ sketches/ pictures depicting the characters or any part of the story that you liked.

Prepare a bookmark to describe the story and what you liked in the book. You can add pictures to make it more creative. In addition, prepare a speech describing your understanding of the above points. It should be around 1 to 1 min 30 seconds to be presented in front of the entire class after the school reopens.

2. Draw!

Let's create a storyboard based on the story you have read. Use pictures, cartoons, illustrations or sketches to explain the theme of the story. Write in one or two sentences the moral of the story.

SUBJECT-SCIENCE

Q1. Leaf Mandala

The word 'Mandala' means circular in Sanskrit. A leaf mandala is a circular art form that is made using different leaves.

Collect some fallen leaves of different shapes. Place them between the folds of a newspaper till you have enough leaves to create a pattern. Think of a circular pattern. Make a rough drawing of the pattern on paper to plan your layout of leaves. Follow your plan and carefully place the leaves on a clean surface indoors. Begin from the centre. If you wish, you can modify your pattern. You may use a flower or two to complete your pattern.

Q2. Study the diagram of the solar system from the books.

Crumple pieces of newspaper into small balls of different sizes. Cover these balls with tissue papers with the help of glue or liquid adhesive. Use these paper balls to create the Sun and all the eight planets. Colour the planets and the Sun.

SUBJECT-SOCIAL SCIENCE

On an outline political map of India mark and label any one state in The Northern Mountains and The Northern Plains and write about the differences in the life of the people living in these two selected state. Include the following points to write the differences and paste pictures-

- a. Occupations
- b. Food crops grown
- c. Dresses
- d. Monuments
