SUBJECT-ENGLISH

1. Be the Chef for a Day!

Choose a regional dish that you like and can make. Write a detailed recipe for it in an A4 size coloured sheet using the following points: name of the dish, region of origin, type (main course, starter, dessert, snack), ingredients used, preparation time, cooking time, steps for cooking, garnishing. Add the pictures of: ingredients used, utensils required, final cooked dish. Then, make a short tutorial video to show the process, including the ingredients used, preparation, cooking and garnishing. The voiceover and explanation in the video should be done by the student. The video can be shared on WhatsApp.

2. Email it!

Imagine your best friend has just moved to Noida as he/she got admitted to a new school. Write an email to him/ her on **any one** of the following topics:

- Suggest a book that you have just read and loved, stating reasons as to why you liked it and convince him/ her to read the book
- Suggest a movie that you have just watched and loved, stating reasons as to why he/ she should watch the movie this weekend
- Suggest a holiday location you have visited during your summer break, why you liked it and why
 you think he/she should visit there with his/her family.

BOOK BASED ACTIVITIES

1. Collage

SUBJECT-SCIENCE

Q1 Prepare ball and stick model of any two following molecules with the help of medium sized plastic balls and straw. Ammonia, Carbon dioxide, nitrogen, Sulphur

OR

Make a model of human skeleton using sticks/ear buds. You can cut the sticks into different sizes to represent skeleton bones. Paste the pieces on a black card paper to represent different parts of skeleton. Draw a human skull and paste it at the top of the spine. The skeleton is ready.

You can place the arms and legs in different positions to create a dancing or walking skeleton (for reference see page no.93 of your text book)

Q2. Van Mahotsav is an annual tree planting festival celebrated in India. Make a poster with colourful illustrations for Van Mahotsav. Write a catchy slogan.
