SUBJECT-MATHEMATICS

1. **Tangrams** are the most popular of all the Chinese puzzles. It is made up of seven flat shapes known in Chinese as "tans".

The seven-tangram pieces always have the same shapes, but the puzzle can be made any size.

The shapes are: 2 large triangles, 1 medium triangle, 2 small triangles, a square, a parallelogram.

The aim of the game is to take the jumbled-up shapes and fit them together to make particular images or silhouettes. The rules of the Chinese tangram game are very easy to learn. The rules are:

- *to solve each puzzle, you have to use all seven shapes
- *each shape must touch at least one other shape

*the shapes must not overlap.
