SUBJECT-ENGLISH

Publish it!

Choose a theme and design *an English magazine* of 6-8 pages. It should have the following:

- An attractive cover page and name of the magazine
- Two articles on the city of your choice
- An interesting, self-written story and poem
- English riddles/amazing facts
- 5 idioms and 5 proverbs depicted pictorially related to the theme/ title of the magazine
- Crossword/Word puzzle
- Famous quotes related to the theme of the magazine
- Poster related to the theme

Make your magazine visually attractive with relevant, meaningful information. For an attractive layout of your magazine, you may take help from various issues of popular magazines like CARAVAN, BRUNCH, TINKLE, OUTLOOK, INDIA TODAY.

BOOK BASED ACTIVITIES (Choose any one)

Dramatic Monologue

Choose a character from the novel you're allotted. Understand the mindset, perspectives and role of the character in the story. Create a monologue for this character in a scene from the novel in not more than 150- 200 words. What are they thinking or feeling at that moment? Why? Choose the words carefully. Submit the script to your teacher once the school reopens and present the same infront of the class.

Roundtable

We all read a story, like some part of it, dislike some other parts and maybe, remain confused with a few. Think about what intrigues, bothers or confuses you about the novel and write it down on A4 sheet. Mention a separate sub-heading or sub-title for each part. Explain your expectations and how the story doesn't match those.

Once the school reopens, we will organise a roundtable discussion with the group members in front of the entire class where you will present these ideas from the book.

SUBJECT-HINDI

SUBJECT-MATHEMATICS

- 1. **IPL 2023**: Collect the data of IPL matches 2023 of your favorite team. Make a table of runs scored by the winning team on each day and represent the information graphically through a bar graph by choosing an appropriate scale. Color the bars with the respective colors of teams.
- 2. The word **mandala** is a Sanskrit term that means "circle" or "discoid object". A mandala can be defined in two ways: externally as a schematic visual representation of the universe and internally as a guide for several psychophysical practices that take place in many Asian traditions, including meditation.

Mandalas include a variety of geometric shapes using patterns that have evolved from different symbols. Mandalas come in many styles and can be created using an unlimited array of materials:

Q2. Make your own charge detector. Take a paper strip roughly 10cmx3cm. Give it a shape of your choice. Bring a charged body near it. Observe what happens. Write a brief report, explain its working.

SUBJECT-SOCIAL SCIENCE

1. Poster Making- Make a poster on 'Conservation of Resource'. Poster can depict problems of resource depletion, use of alternate resources and any innovative methods. You may choose any one resource from—Land, soil, water and natural vegetation and wildlife. Use A3 size Sheet. Poster should be neat and creative.
