Children are born with natural curiosity and inquisitiveness about the world around them. It is important for us to help them keep this spark alive and to make learning fun. Summer Vacation is just round the corner, let every moment of this vacation be a time to unite, connect and enjoy beautiful moments with your child. To keep our little ones busy with some creative and constructive activities, we are sending a few assignments that would help the children get a grasp of the work done in the school. Parents are advised to guide, motivate and facilitate their children to complete their holiday homework, on their own.

So let's follow:

- ← Get up early in the morning and go for a morning walk. Count the number of trees, cars, stones, flowers etc.
- ← Feel the fresh air. Take a deep breathe and do breathing exercises.
- ← Greet with a smile when someone comes in the house.

- ← Speaking politely and sharing with cousins
- ← Answering the phone calls with a polite "Hello", also asking "May I know who is calling?"
- ← Plant a sapling and water it every day and also keep a bowl of water for birds.
- ← Encourage kids to eat healthy food and drink lots of water during summer.

Let's converse in English

Motivate kids to use English as a medium to converse and teach them to use easy words like water, washroom, lunch, May I? Thank you, please etc...., start using small sentences.

- ← How are you? I'm good. Thank You.
- ← I am thirsty. Please give me water.
- ← Please, open / close my tiffin / bottle.
- ← I am hungry. Please give me food.
- ← I have finished my work / food
- ← Please, switch off / on the light / fan

Let's make our kids do few life skills training through various activities like-:

- ← buttoning their shirt
- ← packing their school bags
- ← tying their shoe laces
- ← keeping their belongings back in place
- ← laying the table for dinner
- ← arranging shoes in the shoe rack
- ← filling the water bottles

Fine Motor Development

- **1.** Mix a handful rajma, chickpeas and lobia and ask your child to separate them (under your supervision).
- 2. Scribbling, colouring, mashing potatoes, rolling chapattis, clay moulding, sand play, bursting bubble paper, tearing pasting, pegging the clothes, watering plants with spray bottles also will help you out in fine motor development of your child.

Encourage your little ones to take care of their personal hygiene by inculcating following habits:

- Brushing teeth twice daily.
- Bathing every day.
- Washing hands before and after meals.
- Trimming the nails and keeping them clean

MAKE YOUR HOME A PLACE FOR READING

Here are some tips to help parents of young children to promote reading at home. • Choose a reading time for your child, as in before a nap, bedtime, or after dinner. • Select an age appropriate book for your child.

- Hold the book so that she or he can see the pictures. If possible, also let her or him turn the pages.
- Take some time to look at and talk about the pictures. Don't just read the story; talk about it.
- Let your child point out the letters, shapes, colours and animals.
- Read aloud to your child every day.
